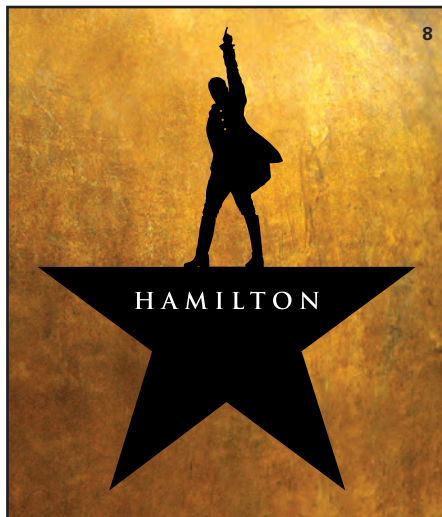

Right-Hand Man

Dr. Robert Morrison keeps the cast and crew of *Hamilton* in revolutionary shape

For Broadway performers, every eight-show week is a marathon, and the wear and tear can be both painful and permanently damaging. As with so much else, prevention proves to be key in terms of a performer's physical health, as well. Which is where people like Dr. Robert Morrison, the official chiropractor and applied kinesiologist for *Hamilton*, come in.

"Broadway performers are similar to athletes because they have a strong constitution and they stay in shape," Morrison says. "When you're dealing with people who are already in very good shape, it's more like fine tuning their range of motions."

The key is posture, which can tell Morrison everything he needs to know about what needs treatment. "One shoulder might be a tad bit higher, and that would give you an idea where muscles are imbalanced," he says. "So then you go in and actually test the muscle to figure out which muscle it is, and then you stimulate the reflex points and adjust the spine. And when you do that, they stand up and you see everything's right where it should be."


Morrison spent 12 years living in Italy and working with football players before moving to New York City in 2014. He was treating a Broadway stage manager when he mentioned that he'd like to become more involved with the community, and she suggested that he contact *Hamilton* about becoming their chiropractor—something that many Broadway shows offer their employees.

But working with a personal trainer and paying attention to nutrition isn't always enough, as Morrison points out. "We all

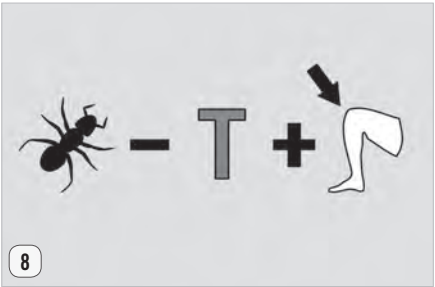
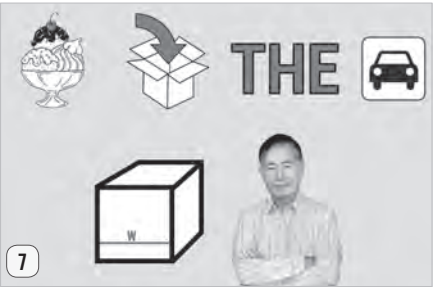
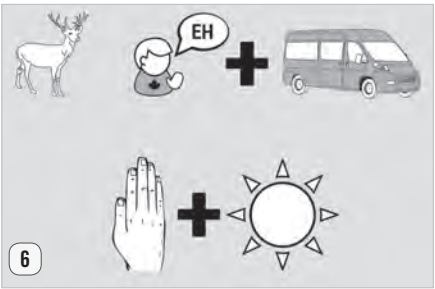
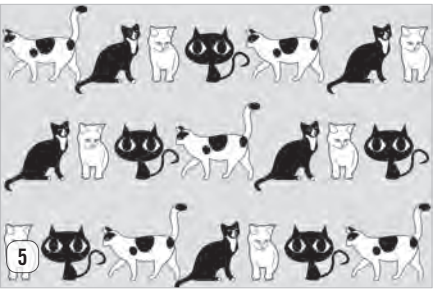
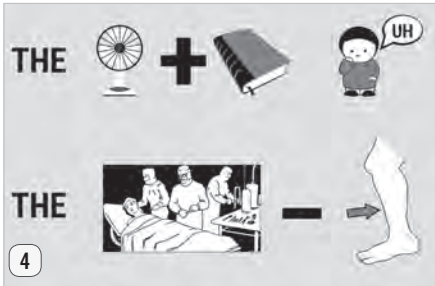
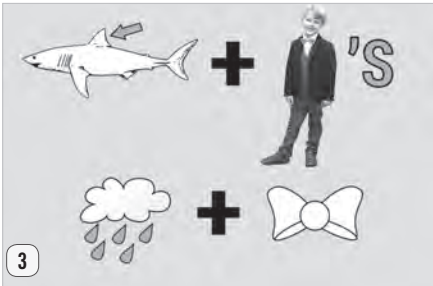
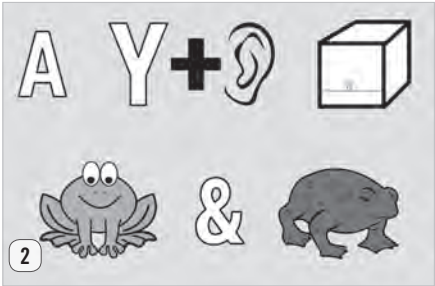
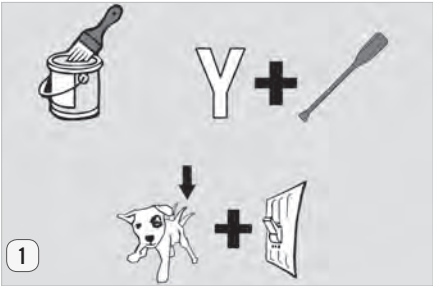
have blind spots, and we might be eating something that we think is the right thing but it's actually not," he points out. "Those are the things that cause most [muscle] inhibitions."

What Morrison does for the cast of *Hamilton* isn't just for actors and dancers, though. Everyone can benefit from a better aligned body. "The nervous system is really designed to run perfectly and anything that interferes, we need to find out what it is and remove it," Morrison says. "You really do have to maintain your body. It's best not to wait until something breaks down and then go in. Preventive care is really the way to go."

The *Hamilton* Effect

Five ways in which the Lin-Manuel Miranda juggernaut has infiltrated the culture

The *Hamilton* Effect

The Founding Father Saves the \$10 Bill

The Treasury Department was prepared to bump Alexander Hamilton off the \$10 bill in favor of a famous American woman to be named later. And then *Hamilton* came along, and made the man on the sawbuck more famous and popular than he had been in a century. In 2016, Treasury Secretary Jacob J. Lew walked back the earlier decision, assuring the world that Hamilton would remain on the \$10.

The Millionaire Historian

Ron Chernow's life changed when Lin-Manuel Miranda picked up his biography of Alexander Hamilton at an airport book shop. Miranda hired Chernow as a consultant for his aborning musical, even cutting him in on the considerable profits the show is generating. More than a decade after it was released, the book ranks in the top ten of Amazon's most-bought volumes.

Little Baby Hamilton


Before the musical, it's doubtful that Alexander Hamilton got more than a mention or two in history classes. That has changed. Educators are using the musical to engage their students. In one of the more notable efforts, the Gilder Lehrman Institute of American History and the Rockefeller Foundation teamed up with the producers of the musical to bring 20,000 11th graders to the show, allowing them to create their own creative interpretations of early American history.

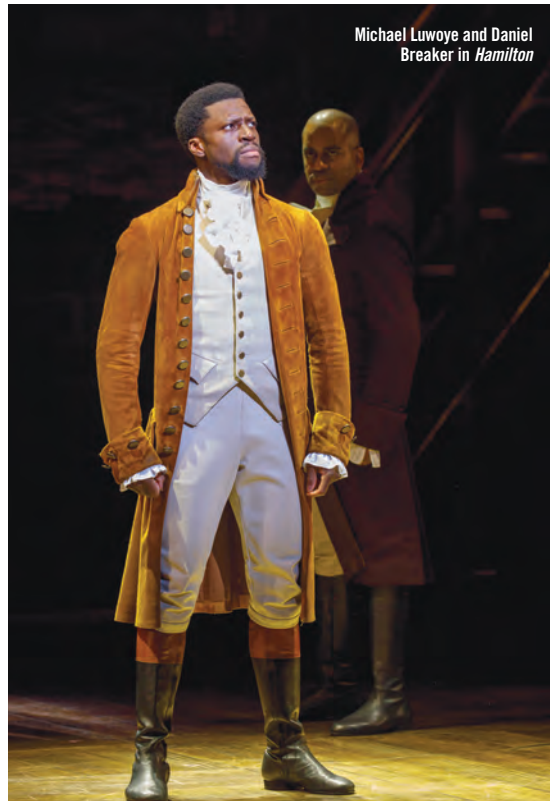
The Name Hamilton Soared in Popularity by 60 Percent in 2015

Forget Noah and Mason. The hot new baby name is Hamilton. According to BabyCenter, which tracks such things, the name

Hamilton soared in popularity by 60 percent over the past year. Other names from the show that have increased in popularity include Jefferson, James, Maria, and George.

You've Seen the Musical, Now Visit the Grave

Hamilton's house in Harlem at the Grange National Memorial, a rare relic of Revolutionary times in Manhattan, has become a popular tourist destination, with a *Hamilton*-themed walking tour of Hamilton Heights and Washington Heights still popular. Additionally, fans flock to the New-York Historical Society for the Burr-Hamilton dueling pistols and Hamilton's final resting place in the Trinity Church yard—as well as the graves of his wife Eliza and friend  Hercules Mulligan.
