

Mr. Palminteri also wrote the screenplay and co-starred in the screen adaptation of A Bronx Tale alongside Robert De Niro. Mr. Palminteri has more than 55 movies to his credit as an actor, writer and director including The Usual Suspects, Bullets Over Broadway (which he was nominated for an Academy Award and won the Independent Spirit Award for Best Supporting Actor), Analyze This, Hurlyburly, Mullholland Falls, Faithful (also written by Mr. Palminteri), A Guide to Recognizing Your Saints, Yonkers Joe, Jolene and, most recently, Legend starring Tom Hardy. 
